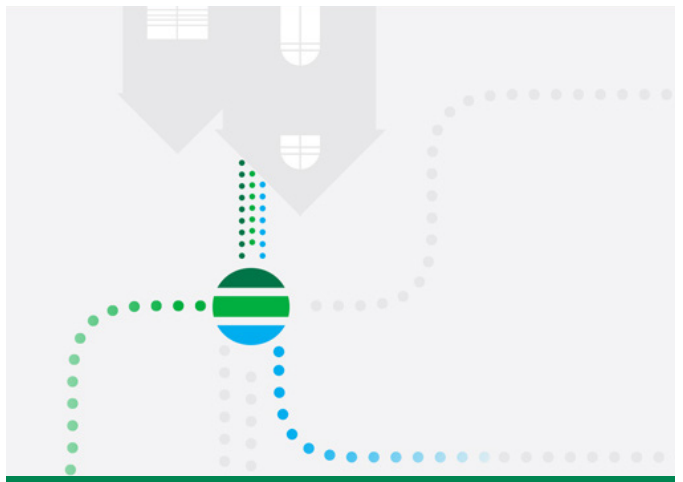

RATES

Our commercial/industrial rates are for non-residential use. Condominium and cooperative common areas may take service on a commercial rate, if qualified.

A9 General – without a demand meter

This rate is for small commercial/industrial customers with demand not exceeding 10 kW.

B1 General – with a demand meter

This rate is for small commercial/industrial customers with demand not exceeding 10 kW. Demand meters are mandatory for all new customers with either three-phase service or single-phase service exceeding 100 amperes.

B2 Large General – Secondary

This rate is for medium-sized commercial and industrial customers where the service voltage is less than 10,000 volts and the monthly demand is greater than 10 kW but less than 200 kW.

B3/G6 Large General Primary Time-of-Use**

This rate is for large commercial and industrial customers where the service voltage is 14,000 volts or more.

B5 Optional General Time-of-Use**

This rate is for commercial and industrial customers with a demand not exceeding 10 kW.

B7/G8 Large General Time-of-Use**

This rate is for large commercial and industrial customers with service voltage of less than 10,000 volts and monthly demand of 10 kW or more.

**Peak hours are from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays from June through Sept. and 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. weekdays from Oct. through May. Off-peak is all other hours including weekends and Mass. holidays.

Eversource offers different rates to best meet your needs. Which rate is best for you depends on a number of factors, including whether you use electricity for heating, meet discount rate guidelines, or use electricity during off-peak hours.

Residential RATES

Our residential rates are for domestic use in single private dwellings, individual apartments or in a residential condominium. Condominium and cooperative common areas may take service on residential rates or any lower commercial rate, if qualified.

A1 Residential Non-Heating

This basic, general use rate is available to all residential customers for lighting, heating and other uses in residential premises. This rate may also apply for condominium common areas and buildings used exclusively for public worship.

A2 Residential Assistance – without electric heat

This discount rate is for residential customers without electric heat who receive certain government means-tested benefits or fuel assistance. This rate is available only to qualified customers in individual private dwellings or individual apartments. A 27 percent discount will be applied to the total bill amount.

A3 Residential Assistance Heating – with electric heat

This discount rate is for residential customers with electric heat who receive certain government means-tested benefits or fuel assistance. This rate is available only to qualified customers in individual private dwellings or individual apartments. A 25.7 percent discount will be applied to the total bill amount.

A4 Residential Space Heating

This heating rate is available to all residential customers with electric space heating throughout their home, as well as electric water heating. This rate may also apply for condominium areas and buildings used exclusively for public worship.

A5 Optional Residential Time-of-Use**

This time-of-use rate is available to all residential customers for lighting, heating and other uses in residential premises. The rate might benefit customers who use most of their electricity during off-peak hours. However, the cost increases if the use is during all other hours.
