Contractors, builders and others who may work near CL&P power lines need to be aware of the potential dangers so they can stay safe.

- At a minimum, you should stay at least 10 feet away from any overhead power line or electrical equipment. This includes any equipment you may use, such as ladders and chainsaws. The minimum distance increases for higher voltages.
