Gas System Upgrades for Better Reliability

At Eversource, safely delivering reliable natural gas is our most important job. As part of those efforts, in 2017 we are investing \$50 million in gas line improvement projects in Connecticut. We're replacing approximately

20 miles of cast iron



and steel pipe with new plastic pipe, which is safer, more durable, and will help strengthen the gas delivery system.

In the past six years, we have replaced almost 120 miles of older gas lines. Building on that commitment, we are currently upgrading gas lines in areas of New London and Stamford. Replacements will continue in the Meriden, Middletown, Putnam and Wallingford communities throughout the year.

Important Natural Gas Safety Reminders

- State law requires that you or your contractor contact Call Before You Dig at 8-1-1 at least two full working days before digging begins.
- Avoid planting around groundmounted utility equipment, such as gas meters and gas vents; Eversource and emergency responders may need to access this equipment.
- Before you start cooking on a natural gas grill, check hoses for cracks and holes. While grilling, keep flammable materials like paper products, linens and clothing away from burners. Don't light cigarettes or matches, or have open flames near a leaking grill.
- If you smell gas, leave the building immediately and call Eversource at 877-944-5325 or 911.
- All Eversource employees carry identification at all times, and most drive a company vehicle. If you believe somebody is falsely claiming to be from Eversource, report the incident immediately to your local police.
