

Important Information about your Energy Service Charge

Eversource adjusts the Energy Service Charge each January 1 and July 1. This is the portion of the bill that reflects costs for energy we purchase on behalf of Eversource customers. Beginning July 1, customers will see this rate transition from 11.17 cents per kilowatt hour to 11.66 cents per kilowatt hour.
