### **January 1 Rates**

The New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission has approved adjustments in Eversource's Energy Service, Stranded Cost Recovery Charge and System Benefits Charge rates effective January 1, 2017.

#### **Energy Service Rate**

10.95 to 11.17 cents per kilowatt hour

#### **Stranded Cost Recovery Charge**

0.084 to 0.027 cents per kilowatt hour

#### **System Benefits Charge**

0.330 to 0.356 cents per kilowatt hour

#### **Energy Service Rate**

The cost of producing or purchasing the energy needed to serve our customers, and applies to customers who purchase their energy from Eversource, and not from a competitive energy supplier. If necessary, the rate is adjusted six months later.



# Important Information about your January 1 Rates

#### **Stranded Cost Recovery Charge**

Included in the stranded cost recovery charge is a credit from revenue associated with the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI) – a program designed to help our environment by reducing emissions of carbon dioxide from fossil fuel power plants while maintaining electricity affordability and reliability. As an Eversource customer, a portion of the revenue the state receives through RGGI from the sale of carbon emission allowances is refunded to you in the form of a credit included in the Stranded Cost Recovery Charge rate.

#### **System Benefits Charge**

The System Benefits Charge helps fund energy efficiency programs available to all Eversource customers
