Carbon Monoxide Awareness

Depending on how you heat your home, your heating system can produce carbon monoxide (CO) if it is not working properly or is inadequately vented. CO has no odor, color or taste, and is very toxic.



Carbon monoxide poisoning symptoms can include headaches, dizziness, nausea, unclear thinking, shortness of breath, weakness, vision problems, and loss of muscle control.

If carbon monoxide is detected by your alarm:

- Alert your family and exit the area immediately.
- Call 911 to notify your local fire department.

Reduce the risk of carbon monoxide poisoning in your home:

- Have your heating system tuned up annually by a licensed heating contractor.
- With a broom or by hand, carefully remove any snow or ice that accumulates around your outdoor gas meters, regulator vents and any other outdoor piping.
- Install carbon monoxide detectors on every floor of your home, and make sure they are working properly.
