

Keep Temperatures Safe with Anti-Scald Devices

Install an anti-scald device at each faucet to help prevent burns from hot water, and save energy. These devices mix hot and cold water to a safe temperature before letting it flow from your faucet. A licensed plumber can inspect your system and install these. You may also ask about available shower fixtures that allow you to set a temperature limit.

Water Temperature

Temperatures above 120 degrees Fahrenheit can cause scalding and third-degree burns in seconds. As a reminder, you should keep your water heater temperature at or slightly below 120 degrees.



Safety Tips:

- Consider installing anti-scald devices on your faucets.
- Always check water temperature, especially for infants, small children and the elderly.
