Business RATES

Our commercial/industrial rates are for non-residential use. Condominium and cooperative common areas may take service on a commercial rate, if qualified.

G0 Small General Service

This rate is for non-residential customers with a load that is less than 349 kW.

T0 Small General Service Time of Use

This rate is for non-residential customers with a load that is less than 349 kW. This rate has peak and off-peak periods.

G2 Primary General Service

This rate is applicable only to the entire use of electricity at a single location where service requires only primary facilities. Such service shall not exceed 349 kW.

T4 Primary General Service Time of Use

This rate is applicable only to the entire use of electricity at a single location where service requires only primary facilities. Such service shall not exceed 349 kW. This rate has peak and off-peak periods.

T2 Large Primary Service Time of Use

This rate is applicable only to the entire use of electricity at a single location where service requires only primary facilities. Customers whose maximum demand equaled or exceeded 350 kW but less than 2,500 kW at any time in the most recent 12 months and new customers whose demand is reasonably anticipated to equal or exceed 350 kW but less than 2,500 kW within one year must take service under this rate. This rate has peak and off-peak periods.

T5 Extra Large Primary Service Time of Use

This rate is applicable only to the entire use of electricity at a single location where service requires only primary facilities. Customers whose maximum demand equaled or exceeded 2,500 kW at any time in the most recent 12 months and new customers whose demand is reasonably anticipated to equal or exceed 2,500 kW within one year must take service under this rate. This rate has peak and off-peak periods.

Eversource offers different rates to best meet your needs. Which rate is best for you depends on a number of factors, including whether you use electricity for heating, meet discount rate guidelines, or use electricity during off-peak hours.

Residential RATES

Our residential rates are for domestic use in single private dwellings, individual apartments or in a residential condominium. Condominium and cooperative common areas may take service on residential rates or any lower commercial rate, if qualified.

R1 Residential

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is not provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment.

R2 Residential Assistance

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is not provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment. To be eligible for this rate, customers need to receive certain means-tested government benefits or fuel assistance. A 36 percent discount will be applied to the total bill amount.

R3 Residential Space Heating

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment.

R4 Residential Space Heating Assistance

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment. To be eligible for this rate, customers need to receive certain means-tested government benefits or fuel assistance. A 36 percent discount will be applied to the total bill amount.
