
Electric RATES

Business RATES

Our commercial/industrial rates are for non-residential use.

Condominium and cooperative common areas may take service on a commercial rate, if qualified.

A9 General (without a demand meter) (G-1)

This rate is for small commercial/industrial customers with demand of less than 10 kW. Customers with a demand exceeding 12 kW in any month will be placed on rate B2.

B1 General (with a demand meter) (G-1)

This rate is for small commercial/industrial customers with demand of less than 10 kW. Demand meters are mandatory for all new customers with either three-phase service, or single-phase service exceeding 100 amperes. Customers with a demand exceeding 12 kW in any month will be placed on rate B2.

B2 General (G-2)

This rate is for medium-sized commercial and industrial customers where the service voltage is less than 10,000 volts and the monthly demand is greater than 10 kW but less than 200 kW.

B3/G6 Time of Use (G-3)

This rate is for large commercial and industrial customers where the service voltage is 14,000 volts or more. This rate has peak and off-peak periods.

B5 Optional Time of Use (T-1)

This rate is for commercial and industrial customers with a demand of less than 10 kW. This rate has peak and off-peak periods.

B7/G8 Time of Use (T-2)

This rate is for large commercial and industrial customers with a service voltage of less than 10,000 volts and a monthly demand of 10 kW or more. This rate has peak and off-peak periods.

Residential RATES

Our residential rates are for domestic use in single private dwellings, individual apartments or in a residential condominium. Condominium and cooperative common areas may take service on residential rates or any lower commercial rate, if qualified.

A1/A5 Residential (R-1)

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is not provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment.

A2 Residential Assistance (R-2)

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is not provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment. To be eligible for this rate, customers need to receive certain means-tested government benefits or fuel assistance. A 36 percent discount will be applied to the total bill amount.

A4 Residential Space Heating (R-3)

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment.

A3 Residential Space Heating Assistance (R-4)

This rate is available to all domestic uses in a single private dwelling, in an individual apartment or in a residential condominium in which the principal means of heating the premises is provided by permanently installed electric space heating equipment.

To be eligible for this rate, customers need to receive certain means-tested government benefits or fuel assistance. A 36 percent discount will be applied to the total bill amount.
