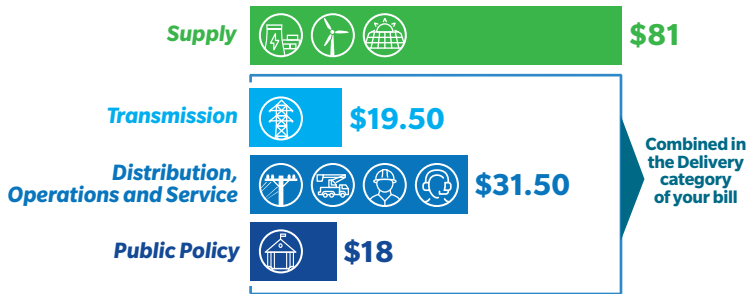


Your Electric Bill: What Are You Paying For?

Energy bills are confusing. Several line items make up your bill, but they really fall into four categories – all of which are driven by the amount of electricity you use.

If your electric bill was \$150, the breakdown would look like this:

Record high natural gas prices are driving energy costs up across the region.

This means your electric bill may be higher than normal this summer.

Your electric supply rate is also adjusted every July 1 and Jan. 1.

On July 1, customers who receive Basic Service electric supply from Eversource (vs. a third party) will see an increase of \$11.59 for an average customer using 550 kWh per month.
