## Building a Reliable Electric System for Today and the Future

All year long, Eversource is in your community working to build a more reliable electric system – one that can also help support clean energy technologies like solar and wind.

So crews can restore service as quickly and safely as possible, we've been installing stronger poles and wires that can better stand up to New England weather, and smart switches that shorten power outages and isolate outage areas.

We've also been upgrading substations that are key to delivering electricity to your home and trimming trees and branches around wires and equipment.

Combined, these efforts contributed to approximately 26% fewer outages throughout the Eversource service territory last summer compared to a year ago.

In New Hampshire, outages were down by more than 47% compared to 2018. The average length of a customer's outage also decreased by nearly 20 minutes for the same period.

## What's in Your Storm Kit?



With the first signs of an approaching storm, make sure you have what you need.

- Build an emergency kit with the essentials, including first-aid supplies.
- Be attentive to severe weather warnings. Have a battery-powered radio available.
- Stock up on non-perishable canned goods and pet food, and make sure you have adequate medical supplies and prescription medications for yourself and your pets.
- Have extra cash on hand in case ATMs don't work.
- Fully charge your cell phone and a portable, phone-charging battery pack.
- Download the free Eversource mobile app to report outages or check for updates.
