## August 1 Rates

The New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission has approved adjustments in Eversource's Energy Service, Distribution, Stranded Cost Recovery Charge and Transmission Charge rates effective August 1, 2019.

### Energy Service Rate

9.985 to 8.825 cents per kilowatt hour

### Average Distribution Rate

4.368 to 4.754 cents per kilowatt hour

### Average Stranded Cost Recovery Charge

1.116 to 1.380 cents per kilowatt hour

### Average Transmission Charge

1.864 to 2.051 cents per kilowatt hour

### Energy Service Rate

The cost of producing or purchasing the energy needed to serve our customers, and applies to customers who purchase their energy from Eversource, and not from a competitive energy supplier. The rate is adjusted every six months.



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### **Distribution Rates**

A temporary rate increase was approved to recover the costs associated with infrastructure upgrades, storm costs, and vegetation management costs. These distribution rates are expected to remain in effect through June 30, 2020.

### **Stranded Cost Recovery Charge**

Included in the stranded cost recovery charge is a credit from revenue associated with the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI) – a program designed to help our environment by reducing emissions of carbon dioxide from fossil fuel power plants while maintaining electricity affordability and reliability. As an Eversource customer, a portion of the revenue the state receives through RGGI from the sale of carbon emission allowances is refunded to you in the form of a credit included in the Stranded Cost Recovery Charge rate. If necessary, the rate is adjusted six months later.

### **Transmission Charge**

This charge recovers costs related to the delivery of electricity over the high-voltage or transmission system power lines. The rate is adjusted each August 1.
