

Important Information about your Rates

Energy Service Charge

Eversource adjusts the Energy Service Charge each February 1 and August 1. This is the portion of the bill that reflects costs for energy we purchase on behalf of Eversource customers. Beginning February 1, customers will see this rate transition from 9.412 cents per kilowatt hour to 9.99 cents per kilowatt hour. Systems Benefits Charge

The Systems Benefits Charge helps fund energy efficiency programs available to all Eversource customers. Effective January 1, the system benefits charge (SBC) increased from 0.455 cents per kilowatt hour to 0.586 cents per kilowatt hour. This increase is due to an expansion of the energy efficiency services available to our customers in 2019.

Electricity Consumption Tax

The electricity consumption tax was repealed by the New Hampshire legislature in 2017 with an effective date of January 1, 2019.
