- *Lowering your thermostat by 3-5 degrees can save you about 10% on heating costs. Likewise, lowering your water heater temperature can reduce its energy use by 4-22% annually.*

## Generator Safety

A generator can be a great backup plan if the power goes out, but it must be used safely. Taking the proper precautions can help protect you, your family, your neighbors and our crews working to restore power.

For your safety and the safety of those around you, generators should always be installed by a licensed electrician, used outdoors and kept as far from the home as possible, away from doors, windows and air vents.



If you plan to use a generator while your electric service is off, follow all manufacturer-provided safety precautions. If your generator is manually operated, be sure that the transfer switch is set to prevent electric back feed.
