Environmental Spills during Storm Restoration

During an ERP, Eversource personnel and contractors that encounter spills or **leaking oil-filled equipment** are required to **take immediate action and provide correct details** to ensure compliance.



LEAKING Oil-Filled Equipment.

This includes seeping or weeping.

Eversource crew calls the Event Room to report the spill then bags and transports to the applicable work center and stores in the proper storage area.

Mutual aid crew through their Eversource contact reports the spill, cuts away unit, bags and leaves onsite.

Steps for Spills and Leaking Equipment:

Assess and contain the spill (berm with spill kit if available).

Contain the leaking equipment.

Mutual aid crew through their Eversource contact reports the spill, cuts away unit, bags or overpacks and leaves onsite.

Steps for Spills and Leaking Equipment:

Assess and contain the spill (berm with spill kit if available).

Contain the leaking equipment.

Eversource Contact Calls the NH System Operations Center State Wide at 603-634-2400.

Reminder — **Leaking or non Leaking equipment must not be** transported from its outage location to any staging area. In all cases, before a crew leaves a site, every attempt should be made to disconnect, contain, and move the unit to a safe storage place onsite.

FOR ALL THREE STATES

Provide accurate and complete information:

- a. Pole or Pad Number
- b. Street address referencing nearest house number and cross street
- c. Town
- d. Your Name and callback number
- e. Estimated quantity of oil released
- f. Impacted surfaces, including observation of any waterway impact
- g. Equipment manufacturer, serial #, ppm PCB of the transformer (nameplate/sticker)
- h. If the area is safe/accessible for our spill cleanup vendor
