Termination of COVID-19 Force Majeure Notification - MA

Due to the then developing COVID-19 crisis, on March 27, 2020, NSTAR Electric Company d/b/a Eversource Energy ("the Company") determined the need to declare a COVID-19 Force Majeure Event ("Event") pursuant to the "Standards for Interconnection of Distributed Generation", MDPU No. 55A ("Tariff") Section 3.7. This message is to apprise you that the Event will end on Thursday, May 11, 2023, to align with the end of the Massachusetts and federal COVID-19 public health emergencies ("Event Termination").

The Company is notifying all customers who have an application or project in process of this Event Termination. If we determined before May 11, 2023, that your project was being directly impacted by this Event, we notified you of the specific effects on your project, including whether your project would be placed on hold, or otherwise delayed, during the Event, and we will follow up with you directly about next steps. Please note that termination of this Event does not preclude the Company from determining the need to declare any other Force Majeure Event pursuant to the Tariff.
