Notice to Retailers: The direct payment permit holder **must** purchase, lease, or rent all tangible personal property and services without paying Connecticut sales and use tax to the retailer except for purchases listed above that are not allowed with the direct payment permit. Maintain this permit, attached documents, and bills or invoices to the purchaser for at least six years from the date when the items or services were purchased. The bills, invoices, or records covering the purchases made under this permit must be appropriately marked to indicate that untaxed purchases were made. The words "purchased with direct payment permit" satisfy this requirement.

No Transfer or Assignment of This Permit: This permit may not be transferred or assigned. This permit is valid from the effective date until revoked by DRS or surrendered by the permit holder.

Misuse of This Permit: DRS may revoke this permit and will impose penalties for misuse of this permit.
