East Eagle Street Substation Emergency Response



- Eversource coordinates and develops emergency response plans with the Boston Fire Department and Eversource's All Hazards Emergency Response Plan
 - Each substation is unique in design and construction. A response plan will be developed in consultation with BFD and include a plan of the substation showing connection points for fire fighting, areas of refuge, tactical positions and access/egress points in order to address the emergency and protect the public.
 - Eversource is the primary responder with BFD in support. Eversource presence is necessary for BFD to safely access substation
 - The substation fire suppression system has been chosen in conjunction with BFD
 - Each transformer will be equipped with an automatic high-pressure water mist fire suppression system designed and installed in accordance with National Fire Protection Association standards.
 - Transformers are surrounded by structural fire walls
 - Eversource typically conducts training with the BFD, including, but not limited to:
 - Station tours, which would include East Eagle, to review plans and procedures
 - Recruit sessions at the Academy
 - Command Staff sessions for High Voltage Safety and review of standard operating procedures
 - Additional meetings regarding technical matters with respect to interface of operations
 - Specific location training for unique scenarios as required
